

New payment method to be implemented for companies and businesses

A new access control system is being implemented for visits to the Bromma, Lövsta, Östberga, Sättra and Vantör recycling centres. This means new payment procedures for anyone dropping off business waste.

- Company registered light trucks will be automatically registered for payment per visit. The access control system generates an invoice that is sent to the company once per month.
- Private vehicles and vehicles with foreign registration are not automatically registered. Visits with either of those vehicles will need to be manually registered by on-site personnel when you drop off business waste. In those cases, you will receive an invoice on the spot.

It is the responsibility of on-site personnel to decide what is and is not considered as business waste.

How it works

Upon entry to the recycling centre, sensors scan the vehicle's registration plate. Company registered light trucks will receive an invoice that will be sent to the company's address. In the event of more than one visit within the same month, all fees for that month will be included in one invoice. The fee per visit is SEK 600 excluding VAT.

Start Date

The access control system is scheduled to begin in January/February 2022.
