- Wine corks, capsules













- The paper bags supplied must be placed in the waste bin. The bin must be washed out and cleaned on a regular basis.
- Don't fill the bin to the top, leave at least 25 cm free from the top. Bins must not weigh more than 60 kg.
- Keep bins cool and place them well into the room in order to avoid rubbish other than food waste being put in them.
- Bins with incorrectly sorted food waste will not be collected. Transfer incorrectly sorted waste to ordinary waste collection or order an extra collection of household waste.
